## INVITATION TO TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF A STATIONARY DOUBLE SHAFT INDUSTRIAL TYRE SHREDDER

1. The Sanitation Service Authority is inviting Tenders for the supply and installation of a purpose-built industrial shredder at the Mangrove Pond Landfill, Vacluse, St. Thomas, Barbados.
2. All tenders must be submitted with prices quoted in Barbados and US currencies.
3. All prices quoted must be V.A.T inclusive and show other costs including local or international freight and duties.
4. Tenders must carry a bid validity period of one (1) year.
5. Tenders must be submitted in sealed envelopes accompanied by an electronic version on USB key marked “**Invitation to Tender for the Supply and Installation of a Stationary Double Shaft Industrial Tyre Shredder**” addressed to the Chairman, Sanitation Service Authority, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor National Petroleum Corporation Building, Wildey, St. Michael, to reach him **no later than 12:00 p.m., noon, on Friday, November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021**. Late submissions **will not** be accepted.
6. **Envelopes must not bear the name(s) of the tenderers.**
7. In the case of an International Tenderer a local agent must be nominated to represent their interest.
8. The Tenderer must provide evidence and references of being a recognized supplier or manufacturer of tire shredders and shall provide all necessary test certificates and other existing documents to verify that the equipment is commercially available and functioning.
9. Tenderers should be aware that the Labour Clauses (Public Contracts) Act 349 shall in so far as is applicable to the tender, apply to any contracts made in respect of the application. Full details of the conditions of the Act 349 may be obtained from the Chief Labour Officer, Labour Department, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor East Warrens Office Complex, Warrens, St. Michael.
10. All submissions must include a Certificate of Incorporation, V.A.T Registration Number and Certificate of Clearance. A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation must be included as evidence of the fact that the Company is an existing registered company as of the date of the tender submission. The Certificate of Incorporation must bear the name of the tenderer and failure to provide the certificate will render the tender void.

11. The Certificate of Incorporation refers to a certificate issued under the 1985 Companies Act of Barbados or where applicable a Certificate of Continuance and/or a Certificate of Amalgamation or a Certificate of Amendment. Such Certificates must be dated after 31<sup>st</sup> December, 1984.
12. In the case where a company is incorporated outside of Barbados has been awarded the contract, it must be registered under the “*Companies Act of Barbados*”.
13. Consideration will not be given to any tender that is not compliant with the conditions set out in this Tender Notice.
14. The Sanitation Service Authority does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender.
