BCRC–Caribbean Launches Digital Learning Hub!

The Basel Convention Regional Centre for Training and Technology Transfer for the Caribbean (BCRC–Caribbean) officially launched its Digital Learning Hub (DLH) on October 21, 2025, marking an important step in expanding access to environmental training and knowledge sharing across the Caribbean and beyond.

The Digital Learning Hub was developed under Output 1.2 of the GEF ISLANDS Projects (10279 and 10472), with the support of the Global Environment Facility (GEF), the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), and the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO).

Free Environmental Training at Your Fingertips

Through the DLH, training programmes developed under the GEF ISLANDS Projects are now available free of charge. Learners from across the globe can access self-paced e-learning courses on the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) and the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs).

Looking ahead to 2026, BCRC–Caribbean will introduce four additional courses covering a range of chemicals and waste management topics, further strengthening regional capacity and knowledge.

- Sector-specific professionals in customs and excise, standards, and agriculture
- Public sector personnel within ministries responsible for environment, agriculture, and education
- University students and academic researchers
